



Azerbaijan – South Africa Bilateral Relations

Diplomatic relations between the two countries were established on April 29, 1992.

1999

South Africa's Ambassador to the Republic of Azerbaijan (with residence in Ankara), Thomas Wheeler paid a visit to Azerbaijan. During the visit, the Ambassador met with the speaker of the Milli Majlis (National Assembly) of the Republic of Azerbaijan Mr. M. Alasgarov, Prime Minister Mr. Artur Rasi-zade, Foreign Minister and other officials.

On May 3, Minister of Foreign Affairs of South Africa visited Azerbaijan

On May 12, President Heydar Aliyev was invited to attend inauguration ceremony of the President of South Africa

On October 22 Deputy Minister of Department of the International Relations of the Republic of South Africa, Mr. A. Pahad, invited Deputy Minister of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of the Republic of Azerbaijan, Mr. K. Khalafov, for official visit.

On August 29-30, the South African Foreign Ministry delegation led by the Head of the European Department Mr. Grobler paid an official visit to Azerbaijan. During the visit, the delegation met with Prime Minister of Azerbaijan Mr. Artur Rasi-zade, Deputy Foreign Minister Mr. Khalaf Khalafov, the President of SOCAR Mr. Natig Aliyev, and Minister of Commerce Mr. F. Aliyev.

2001

On April 4-6 South Africa's Ambassador to the Republic of Azerbaijan (with residence in Ankara), Thomas Wheeler made a farewell visit to Baku.

2004

Ambassador Sobizana Mngikana (with residence in Ankara) presented his credentials to the President of the Republic of Azerbaijan H.E. Mr. Ilham Aliyev.

2005

On October 4-7, Ambassador of the Republic of South Africa accredited in the Republic of Azerbaijan (with residence in Ankara), Mr. Sobizana Mngikana, paid a working visit to Baku. During the visit, he met with the Minister of Foreign Affairs of the Republic of Azerbaijan Mr. Elmar Mammadyarov and Deputy Minister of Economic Development Mr. M. Cabbarov.

2007

On October 22-23, South Africa's Ambassador to Turkey and also accredited in Azerbaijan, Mr. Sobizana Mngikana paid visit to Azerbaijan in connection with the completion of his duties.



2008

On June 10-11 South African delegation led by the First Lady Mrs. Zanele Mbeki attended the International Forum titled "Expanding the Role of Women in Cross-Cultural Dialogue" in Baku.

2009

In February Ambassador Mr. Tebogo Sekolo (with residence in Ankara) presented his credentials to the President of the Republic of Azerbaijan, H.E. Mr. Ilham Aliyev.

2011

On August 16 President of Azerbaijan appointed Mr. Elkhan Polukhov as Ambassador of the Republic of Azerbaijan to the Republic of South Africa.

2012

On January 12 Minister of the Department of International Relations and Cooperation of South Africa Ms. Maite Nkoana-Mashabane met with Minister of Foreign Affairs of Azerbaijan Mr. E. Mammadyarov in New York. Two Ministers discussed issues of common interest such as working together in the UNSC.

On February 1, Ambassador Polukhov presented his credentials to the President of the Republic of South Africa, H.E. Mr. Jacob Zuma.

On October 14-16, official delegation led by the South African Deputy Minister of Defence, Mr. T. Makwelta visited Azerbaijan.

On November 9, Ambassador Mr. V. Khumalo (with residence in Ankara) presented his credentials to the President of the Republic of Azerbaijan, H.E. Mr. Ilham Aliyev.

On November 14-15 Ambassador R. Molekane, Deputy Director-General: Europe Branch conducted an official visit to Azerbaijan for senior officials' political consultations.

2013

On May 7-8 Deputy Minister of the Department of International Relations and Cooperation of South Africa, Mr. Marius Llewellyn Fransman paid an official visit to Azerbaijan.

On 31 October - 1 November, Chairman of the South African's Parliament Commission on Arts, Culture and Heritage, Ms. Thandile Sunduza, together with South Africa's former Ambassador to the Republic of Azerbaijan (1999-2001) and one of the founders of the "Friends of Azerbaijan" NPO, Mr. Thomas Wheeler, participated at the 3rd Baku International Humanitarian Forum.



2014

On February 20-27, Minister of Foreign Affairs of the Republic of Azerbaijan, Mr. Elmar Mammadyarov paid official visit to South Africa, Mozambique and Botswana. As part of his first official visit to the Republic of South Africa, Mr. Mammadyarov met with the Minister of the Department of International Relations and Cooperation of South Africa Ms. Nkoana-Mashabane. During the meeting the "Memorandum of Understanding on Regular diplomatic consultations between the Government of the Republic of Azerbaijan and the Government of the Republic of South Africa" was signed. During his visit to the Republic of South Africa Minister E. Mammadyarov also met with Mr. Dikobe Ben Martins, Minister of Energy of the Republic of South Africa.

In May Mr. Khalaf Khalafov, the Deputy Foreign Minister of the Republic of Azerbaijan received a delegation led by South African Ambassador V. Khumalo.

On July 23 – August 1 Johannesburg Philharmonic Orchestra performed at the Gabala International Music Festival, organised by Heydar Aliyev Foundation.

On August 3-9 the delegation of Azerbaijan Architects Union visited Durban, to attend the XXV International Congress of the International Union of Architects.

On October 2-3, King of Vha Venda Community, H.M. Mr. Toni Peter Mphephu, took part in the IV Baku International Humanitarian Forum.

2015

On 12 October Ambassador Polukhov gave live interview at the 101.9 CHAI FM (Jewish community) radio station in Johannesburg.

On December 6 South African journalist Marianne Schwankhart published article in Sunday Times titled "Azerbaijan: a rare stop on the old Silk Road". The visit of the South African journalists to Azerbaijan was organised by the Ministry of Culture and Tourism of the Republic of Azerbaijan and Embassy of the Republic of Azerbaijan to South Africa.

2016

On 15 March Deputy Minister of Public Services and Administration of the Republic of South Africa, Mrs. Ayanda Dlodlo, visited Azerbaijan and met with Deputy Foreign Minister Mr. Mahmud Mammadgulyev.

On May 5-6 Ambassador Polukhov participated at the African Regional Conference entitled "Open Government for Sustainable Development in Africa" in Cape Town at the invitation of Deputy Minister of Public Services and Administration of the Republic of South Africa, Mrs. Ayanda Dlodlo.



On June 6 Delegation led by Deputy Director of the Department of International Relations and Cooperation (DIRCO) of the South African Republic, Mrs. Judith Maya, held inter-ministerial consultations at the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of Azerbaijan. During the visit, the delegation also held meetings at "ASAN Service", and at the ADA University.

On November **28 – 29** Delegation headed by the Minister of International Relations and Cooperation of the Republic of South Africa, Ms. Maite Nkoana-Mashabane, paid an official visit to the Republic of Azerbaijan. During the visit, Minister met with President Mr. Ilham Aliyev, Minister of Economy Mr. Shahin Mustafayev, Foreign Minister Mr. Elmar Mammadyarov, Director of the Azerbaijan Diplomatic Academy Mr. Hafiz Pashayev and Chairman of ASAN Service Mr. Inam Karimov.

On December 5 Mr. Azad Naghiyev, by the decree of the Minister of Foreign Affairs of the Republic of Azerbaijan, has been appointed as Charge d'Affaires to the Republic of South Africa.

2017

On March 11, Mr. Azad Naghiyev met with Minister of International Relations and Cooperation of the Republic of South Africa, Ms. Maite Nkoana-Mashabane in Richards Bay, KwaZulu-Natal. At the meeting Mr. Naghiyev and Minister Nkoana-Mashabane discussed the various issues of common interests.

On April 26, Mr. Azad Naghiyev gave live interview to Ubuntu Radio (official radio of the Department of International Relations and Cooperation). Interview was dedicated to the 25th Anniversary of the establishment of diplomatic relations between Azerbaijan and South Africa. Mr. Naghiyev described progress made and current developments in the relations between two countries.

On April 27 H.E. President Ilham Aliyev congratulated H.E. President Jacob Zuma with the Freedom Day and expressed his warm wishes to all South Africans.

On May 5-6, delegation led by the Deputy Minister of Arts and Culture, Ms. Makhotsso Magdeline Soty attended the 4th World Forum on Intercultural Dialogue in Baku at the invitation of the Ministry of Culture of the Republic of Azerbaijan and Ministry of Foreign Affairs of the Republic of Azerbaijan.

On May 27 Minister of the Department of International Relations and Cooperation of the Republic of South Africa, Ms. Maite Nkoana-Mashabane and Minister of Foreign Affairs of the Republic of Azerbaijan Mr. E. Mammadyarov exchanged congratulatory letters on the occasion of the 25th Anniversary of the establishment of diplomatic relations between two countries.
